

SAR 10th Anniversary Gun Show in Las Vegas, NV
August 25th & 26th

Exhibit Space: Tables are 8' long and are \$90 for 2 days. You may rent any number of tables. Tables are arranged end to end with dealers on one side and members of the public in the aisle space on the opposite side of the tables. Wall tables are also available. They are arranged around the perimeter of the show, also end to end, for the same price each. Please bring your own certified flame retardant table coverings or purchase at show. Booths are 10'x10' and are \$995.00 for the two-day show.

Cancellation: We will refund your table, booth or conventioner payment less 10% if you cancel more than 6 months ahead of the show date, 50% if you cancel no later than 4 months. Cancellations within 6 weeks of the show date will not be refunded.

Security: We provide overnight security Friday and Saturday nights from closing time until we open the doors in the morning. Security is the exhibitor's responsibility during set up and tear down. Small valuable items should be displayed in glass cases for security. Handguns should be secured with a cable security system through the trigger guards. There will be uniformed and plain-clothes security personnel at the show, during the show hours.

Prohibited Items:

The following are prohibited:

1. Pornographic materials, drug paraphernalia, items that GLORIFY Nazism, items offensive to the general public.
2. Loaded firearms.
3. Loose rounds of ammunition.
4. Black Powder.
5. Anything illegal: Check the Nevada penal code to be sure.
6. Alcoholic beverages unless sold by the concessionaire.
7. Tobacco products.

Regulated Items:

1. All pepper spray must be bubble wrapped.
2. No more than 20lbs of smokeless powder on the table at any one time.
3. The following items must be approved for sale by the show manager and the concessionaire: food and candy.
4. Laser scopes must be operated only by the exhibitors.
5. All guns **MUST** have a tie-wire through the action or trigger.

Behavior: SAR does not wish to tell people how to act. However, since this is our show, and we expect it to be very public, we reserve the right to ask people who act detrimentally towards our public image as responsible firearms owners to leave our show.- Dan
